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PROGRAMS

Our curriculum is based on both Creative Curriculum and Teaching Strategies. It is also aligned with the Pennsylvania State Standards.

Learning centers within the classrooms enhance the curriculum development. Some of the children's favorite centers are art, music, science, and library.

Additionally, we have a gross motor skills and activity room where we hold yoga and athletic-based classes.

INFANTS (6 weeks - 12 months)

Nurturing teachers recognize the importance of infants having responsive adults to meet their needs in a consistent and loving manner. Infants work on gross and fine motor skills and language and cognitive skills through music, exercise and outdoor blanket time sprinkled with lots of fun and giggles.

TODDLERS (12 months - 18 months)

When toddlers work, they are busy mastering walking, running, and other gross and fine motor skills. Logical thinking and imagination encourage exploration on their own. The use of words and thoughts to interact with each other while they spend their day filled with fun and engaging hands-on activities is encouraged.

TWADDLERS/PREPPERS

(18 months - 36 months)

Children are exposed to a variety of activities designed to reach every kind of learner; sensory, auditory and kinesthetic experiences will be available throughout your child's day. Children need a safe and supportive learning environment where they can practice new skills and learn healthy and consistent boundaries.

PRESCHOOL (3 years - 4 years)


Preschoolers are inquisitive and our lessons are planned and implemented based on assessment and individual learning styles. We introduce the children to written, visual, verbal and physical activities involving the alphabet and early literacy skills. We utilize arts and crafts, songs and games, science, language and mathematics.

PRE-K (4 years - 5 years)

We know it is critical for the children to retain and understand concepts so they will be well prepared for Kindergarten. Our goal in Pre-K is for your child to finish the program with the skills, foundation and love of learning that is essential for their future success in school.

SCHOOL AGE (5 years to 12 years)

We offer the perfect transition for children who are preparing their day or just finishing up from their school day. In the morning we provide a healthy breakfast and a snack in the afternoon. Transportation may be available to and from your elementary school. Once school is out for the year, join Summer Camp and have no more boring summers!
